
THE MAYOR'S WALLED CITY TASK FORCE PRESENTS

What's the story behind that slab of tabby standing in Marion Square?

It was once part of the "Horn Work" fortification that served as the city gate and the centerpiece of Charleston's defenses during the British siege of 1780.

Using historic images and descriptions, Dr. Nic Butler will present an illustrated history of the Horn Work from its construction in 1759, its demolition in 1784, and its survival into the twenty-first century.
